# Why this project?

Coastal retreat is about the withdrawal, relocation or abandonment of assets at risk and enabling ecosystems to retreat landward

Retreat is one of the ‘tools’ available for best practice coastal adaptation planning

Stage Four of the South Australian Coastal Hazard Adaptation Planning process involves the identification and assessment of adaptation options including retreat

- To identify the most appropriate options, detailed information on the social, environmental and economic costs and benefits are required





# Why this project?

Coastal retreat as an adaptation option can be challenging to assess due to:

- Need to plan for the longer term and likely implement over many years
- Limited capacity of council teams in understanding the costs and benefits
- The complexity of asset and land ownership
- Interaction with state planning processes
- Uncertainty in the rate of change of coastal and social issues into the future

There is a gap in the availability of more detailed guidance about approaches to retreat

# What will be delivered by the project?


Key deliverable is an Options Paper that can serve as a resource and used for advocacy

Will build on and add value to the Climate Ready Coasts program, Coastal Hazard Adaptation Planning Guidelines and Adaptation Actions Compendium that supports councils to:

- Consider retreat scenarios
- Engage communities
- Navigate the complex and legal considerations

Not a prescriptive toolkit but a strategic document that enables exploration of retreat as part of the broader adaptation planning process
